

2. Students will be more aware and informed about the various careers available in the field of sciences.











The students visited various sectors like, churning and ghee production sectors, where they explored and understood the functioning of various machines used in the dairy. The students were informed about the process of production of different milk products.







Objective of the Activity-



By this exercise the students had an experiential learning and were able to identify a number of trees, observed different patterns of leaves and were able to categorise them.





Objective of the Activity-

Orchid (The Botany Forum) organized a visit to the National Research Centre on Seed Spices, Tabiji on 13th February 2019 which is an apex centre of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) working on improvement of seed species. Students were introduced in brief about the institute by Prof. S.N. Saxena. A career counselling session in agricultural research was taken by Sir Dr. A.K. Verma. The talk was followed by field visit by two scientists Sir Dr. A.K. Verma and Dr. Ravi. The institute also serves to provide knowledge about the utilization of seed spices via KNOWLEDGE PARK in the campus which has all the beneficial products from juices to herbicides made from the seed spices.

Learning Outcome

The students got an exposure to cultivational aspects of various seed spices. They also learned about different varieties of seed spices grown in the research centre and about their economic utility.
