


**Outcome of the Activity:**-Students learned about glorious past of Ajmer through Visual retreat of Light and Sound Show.










#### 3. Quiz on "History of Constitution of India"


**Outcome of Activity**:-Students learned History of Constitution of India with the help of classroom Quiz activity.

**Outcome of Activity**:-Students acquainted themselves with the life and works of Mahatma Gandhi and their relevance in humanity's predicament.










#### 5. Excursion to Government Museum, Ajmer
