

The Movie focussed on fostering a sense of patriotism and nationalism. The movie evoked emotions related to these themes.








7. GUEST LECTURE ON "CONSUMER AWARENESS"

15. GANDHI JAYANTI




"Be clean and keep India clean."




16. NATIONAL SEMINAR ON MAKERS OF MODERN INDIA

Sainath has received numerous prestigious awards, including the Ramon Magsaysay Award and holds over 40 global and national awards for his reporting. He was the first reporter to win Amnesty Integrational swards for his reporting. He was the first reporter to win Amnesty Integrational's Global Human Rights Journalism Prize in 2000. In 2014, he founded the People's Archive of Rural India (PARI), an online platform addressing social and economic inequality, rural affairs, poverty, and the impact of globalization in India. He also widely respected as the Father of Rural Journalism.

Date: 5th October'2023 and 6th October'2023




The main aim of the wildlife week celebration was to raise awareness and promote conservation efforts related wildlife and their habitats.

Date: 26 January'2024
















24. TALK ON ROAD SAFETY
